



The year 2010 was a year of growth nationally and in local areas for FCA Outdoors. The successful events this year will be used as a model by others around the country for 2011. Our goal was to grow the network of financial business partners and individuals to facilitate ministry, equip volunteers to implement ministry events, host national events and to identify grass roots volunteers that were interested in serving in the outdoors locally and in other states.



To do this we stretched our faith and capacity and reached a milestone within the first three months. In January FCA Outdoors hosted a prayer breakfast for the Archery Trade Association (the largest archery association in the Nation). We also co-hosted a Prayer Breakfast for Safari Club International and the Ovis/Grand Slam Club. We completed the winter convention season hosting our most successful Prayer Breakfast in Reno with the **Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation** which sparked the first financial partnership between FCA Outdoors and RMEF in Georgia. Other National events included a ministry presence at the Professional FLW National Fishing Championship Expo, a Father & Son Pheasant Hunt in South Dakota, a Wyoming Sportsmen Retreat Antelope Hunt, a Canadian Fishers' of Men Retreat, a Sportsmen Night in Kansas City and the Fishers' of Men Tournament Trail National Fishing Championship. With over 2000 in attendance at the prayer breakfasts and other national events and another 80,000 exposed to the ministry for the first time, national ministry expansion is expected to be exponential in 2011.



In Georgia, FCA Outdoors presented to FCA Staff, Board members and volunteers in Carroll, Hall, Green, Gwinnett, Butts, Stephens, Coweta and Fayette County ideas and implementation guidelines for having a local Team FCA Outdoors for their area. The result of those meetings was aided by RMEF of Georgia and led to events including a God & Country Sportsmen Expo featuring David Morris of Tecomate, 2 Coaches' Skeet Shoots and Fellowship, a Sportsmen's Dinner with Hank Parker at Rock Eagle, a High School Archery Tournament, a Coaches' Deer Hunt and discipleship weekend, a Family Fishing Day, a Youth Outdoor Leadership Retreat Weekend and a Sportsmen Night with Introductory Youth Archery Shoot. FCA Outdoors

also participated in 3 Church Events with Hank Parker and hosted the first ever **Night of Champions Gala Celebration** with NFL Hall of Famer Jim Kelly. In Georgia alone, FCA Outdoors hosted or participated in events with over 3000 in attendance.

In summary, 2010 was a year where the Outdoors platform was used to share Christ with a multitude of people resulting in hundreds dedicating their lives to service for Christ as volunteers ready to serve in their local level. In 2011 Team FCA Outdoors volunteers will begin ministry in Alabama, Texas, Virginia, Kansas, Oregon, North Carolina, Nevada, and Oklahoma along with more Georgia Staff. With a new National Vision Plan in place along with web-based ministry implementation strategies developed, FCA Outdoors plans to further develop Outdoor Ministry opportunities locally and around the nation. For the National Vision to succeed, Georgia and other states ready for action will be instrumental in further piloting our "Let's Go Outdoors" youth program and our upcoming "FCA Family & Coaches Days" With plans in place and blessings that only God could have ordained and orchestrated, FCA Outdoors seeks those in need of Christ and is committed to serve and reach the Outdoors community.
